TOEFL IBT (destination code: 0895)

Overall 88, with minimum 21 on speaking, and 21 on writing. For Co-op Accounting, overall 100, minimum 27 on writing, and 27 on speaking

CAEL

Overall 70, no other band score under 60

Brock English Placement Test (BEPT)

Minimum overall score of 600, with no subtest below 500

International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma

Completion of the diploma where English was the language of instruction

Full-time study where the primary language of instruction and evaluation is English

A minimum of three years, with acceptable grades in English, and other humanities/social science secondary school courses



If you don't meet our English language proficiency requirements, consider our ESL academic programs.

IELP - conditional admission
