To receive an I-20 and to apply for an F-1 student visa, you must complete this statement of financial responsibility and submit a separate bank statement confirming that the information is true and accurate. If you are receiving a stipend, scholarship or grant, attach a letter or statement from the organization.

Requirements:

- All documents must be in English or translated into English with originals attached.
- Financial documents must be dated within 90 days from the date of submission.
- Do not mail originals. Keep original financial documents for future reference or to apply for a visa.
