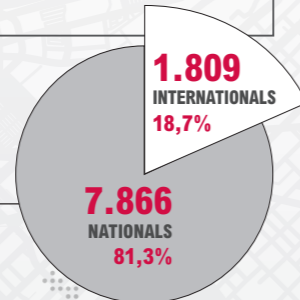

International Semester Programmes

Nebrija University has a wide range of courses aimed at international university students who wish to complete one or two semesters of their education in Madrid.

Our international programmes offer students the opportunity to integrate themselves into the social and academic life of a Spanish university. Each Integrated Programme, includes undergraduate degree subjects which are shared with Spanish students.

The students may choose freely among the subjects offered within each international programme, which is assigned to a specific campus.

Orientation sessions

All international students are invited to participate in orientation sessions given prior to each semester. The aim of these sessions is to enroll the students and give them a panoramic view of Spanish life, cultural and academic differences, as well as information about daily life in Madrid: public transportation, medical facilities, banks, etc.

- 3° Summer courses:** June and/or July

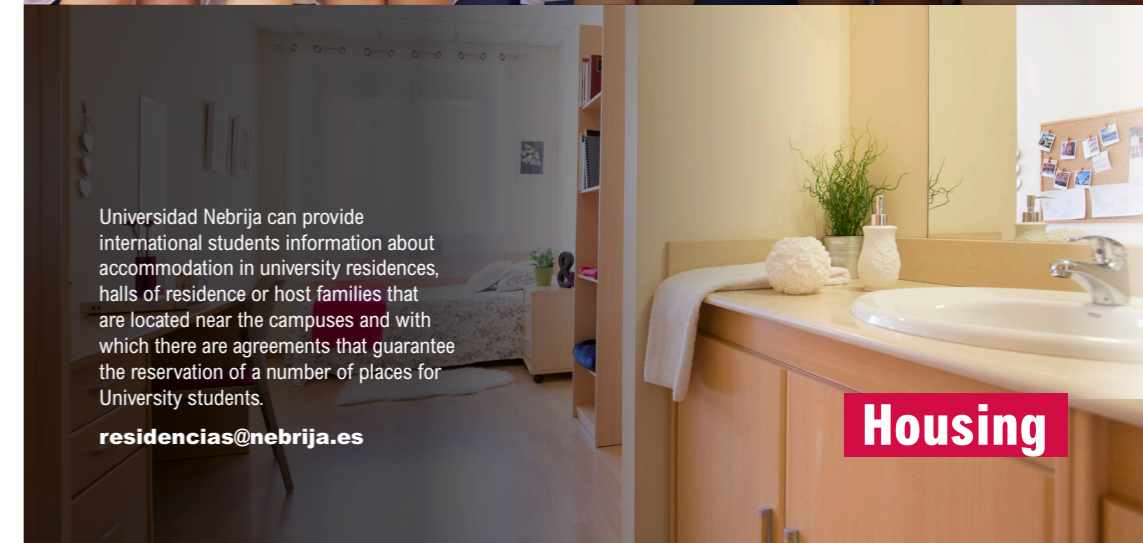


Nebrija Sports and Clubs

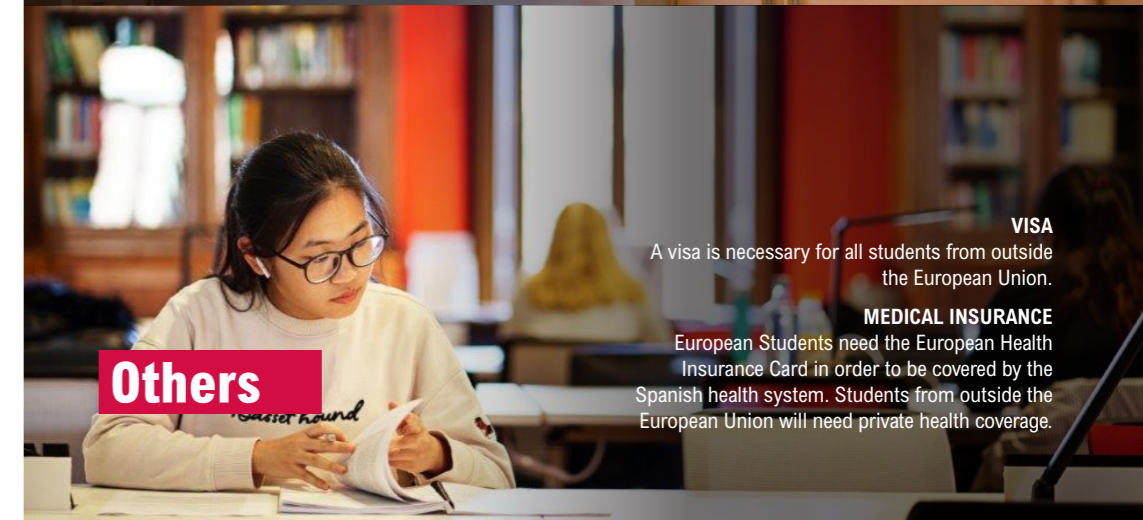
