The Luiss educational model combines academic rigor with practical relevance.



The aim of the three-year Bachelor's degree program in Economics and Business is to train open-minded, internationally-focused graduates. The course provides solid, general preparation in the most important economic fields and offers an excellent introduction to the fields of business and finance.

In addition, students acquire solid methodological tools to understand and analyze economic and financial phenomena, including the acquisition of basic legal concepts taught within an economic framework. The three majors are Management, Economics, and Finance, giving students the chance to prepare for master's programs.

As part of a university-wide initiative to further teaching and research in the emerging fields of digital management and data science, the Department of Business and Management offers a Bachelor's degree in Management and Computer Science, aimed at providing students with a unique educational opportunity in data science.

Co-designed by academic and business partners, this program weaves economics and management disciplines with courses in coding, machine learning and artificial intelligence to forge a new breed of digital talents. In a data-driven era, managers must have interdisciplinary skills - strategic and organizational knowledge as well as computing abilities - to discover patterns in data and turn them into actionable information that creates value.

The Politics, Philosophy, and Economics (PPE) bachelor's degree program prepares students for a truly international career from day one of their college education. Students will gain a broad understanding of and exposure to various disciplines and their impact on societies today, including: history and law, political science, sociology, economics and statistics. PPE graduates will develop a portfolio of knowledge, competencies and skills that will serve them as they navigate the complexities of the interconnected contemporary world.

The PPE program utilizes an interdisciplinary approach to understand current affairs from political, economic, legal and sociological perspectives and an international approach both in terms of the topics covered and the faculty presenting them. It also takes a critical approach to contemporary politics, allowing students to acquire an in-depth understanding of political and institutional phenomena.

Global Management and Politics

The Master's degree program in Global Management and Politics – offered by the Department of Business and Management in cooperation with the Department of Political Science – complements topics related to management with socio-political issues, as global managers must be aware of the intricacies of world politics.

The study plan starts with the exploration of the economic, legal and economic-business foundations of global management.

The course of studies then moves on to organizational and strategic issues and ends with the analysis of important issues related to the political implications of globalization, international relations, the dynamics of international governmental and non-governmental organizations and activities related to representing corporate, stakeholder and institutional interests.

The Master's program trains professionals to perform managerial and specialist functions within international organizations, particularly in the context of global industries and services, strategic consulting firms, as well as institutions operating at supranational and international levels.


International Relations

The Luiss Master's program in International Relations prepares graduates for careers in diplomacy, as international security experts for both the public and private sectors and in the management of Euro-Mediterranean issues. The program responds to the growing need for highly trained figures (in international organizations and in the traditional diplomatic sector) that are able to handle both old and newly emerging challenges. The program branches out into three majors: Security, Mediterranean Governance and Diplomacy.

The major in **Security** provides tools to analyze security issues and challenges. Students will be trained to deepen their knowledge of geopolitical and strategic dynamics not only at European level but also on a global scale.

The major in **Diplomacy** aims to train diplomatic personnel that are equipped to join international representation around the world.

The major in Mediterranean Governance focuses on the politics, sociology and cultures of Mediterranean countries as well as the different kinds of political systems and migration policies.



Law, Digital Innovation and Sustainability

The Master's degree in Law, Digital Innovation and Sustainability equips experts in innovation – and in particular, students with a legal or managerial background – with the instruments necessary to interpret the current digital and ecological transitions in society and the economy, offering them a solid legal background with equally strong interdisciplinary, managerial and technical knowledge.

The **Digitalization** major prepares students with an understanding of how digital technologies are changing business models, providing new revenue sources and value-producing opportunities, and defining new value-sharing approaches. It then broadens

their skills and competencies, enabling them to connect the legal and business aspects of digital transformation processes and generate integrated systemic solutions (e.g. business units, legal solutions, institutional/regulatory/policy innovations, new ventures, etc.) by drawing from a wide range of social and technical sciences.

The Sustainability major takes an in-depth look at climate change and its consequential social changes and how they affect traditional business models. It empowers students to create new models, define new revenue sources and value-producing opportunities, and forge new value-sharing approaches in order to identify and influence systemic

solutions for sustainable development, urban prosperity and territorial growth.

Policies and Governance in Europe

The Master's degree in Policies and Governance in Europe (PAGE) responds to a changing world in which policy decisions are taken at different but interconnected levels. It prepares students to use public policy analysis in the outside world by drawing on different disciplines. The track focuses on how and why policy makers create, use and manage cultural heritage, which includes historic buildings, museums, cities, food and intangible heritage.

The Master's degree in Policies and Governance in Europe covers major policies made at EU, international, national, regional and local levels. It is multidisciplinary and includes the study of political science, law and economics, sociology and management. It offers a combination of analytical skills, knowledge of key domains and specific competencies. It is designed for public and private sector organizations (e.g. government agencies, EU and international institutions, museums, associations, local and regional development offices).

The program offers two majors, Cultural Heritage Policies and Economics, Governance and Market Regulation.

The MSc in Strategic Management at Luiss offers a unique opportunity for students to become top managers, leaders and analysts by providing a success-oriented educational environment and exposure.




Department of Law


Luiss School of European Political Economy

Luiss Residences

Lisbona

Scholarship

The Adoption Lab Project connects students with companies, helping them to deepen their knowledge of the work environment.

The employers of leading companies "adopt" selected students, offering them the chance to work on projects and do an internship upon graduation.

During the first year of the program, AdLab arranges visits to headquarters of partner companies and meetings with employers, who explain company policies and the skills required to reach important professional goals.

The second year focuses on putting acquired skills to work and testing participants' problem-solving and teamwork skills. In addition, host companies give AdLab students specific projects to work on as consultants. Luiss tutors collaborate with teams and companies, supervising the activities. At the end of the first semester of the second year, students present their projects to employers, who provides feedback on the collaboration period as offering advice regarding résumé preparation.

Top students may be offered an internship at a partner company after graduation.

Renovated both in terms of its vision and spaces, the Luiss Library is specialized in the Social Sciences and serves as the primary reference point for scientific research, supplying constant support to the teaching programs of the University.

In order to strengthen the digital services offered, the Library offers offcampus access to its online catalog and electronic collections with over 500,000 e-books, more than 170,000 e-journals and 180 databases.

The Library is open from Monday to Saturday. Its open and multifunctional spaces give students the opportunity to study, take advantage of the bibliographic research support services, and access the print collections, with around 103,000 books and over 1,170 magazines.

In addition to guaranteeing quality academics, Luiss offers a variety of financial aid programs and services to support students who decide to invest in their futures and maintain high academic standards throughout their careers.

International Admissions Procedure

For students obtaining a secondary school diploma abroad there will be rolling admissions for the entire academic year (November 2, 2020 – June 11, 2021). For the criteria, modalities and timelines, please consult the admissions calls, which will be published on the <u>luiss.edu</u> website.

During the application phase, candidates may indicate up to three degree programs, in order of preference, for which they wish to compete. The second and third choices will only be taken into consideration in case of non-admission to the first choice. For admission purposes, the Admission Boards will evaluate, at their sole discretion, the academic background and transcripts of records, rankings of the origin school/institute, the school year in which the eligible qualification was awarded (preference will be accorded to qualifications conferred in the last three academic years), the language level declared and the highly recommended certificates (i.e. SAT, ACT, GMAT, GRE).

Only those candidates identified by the Commission as possible scholarship candidates may be contacted to arrange a Skype call.

Documents or data required to complete the online application (in pdf or image format):

- I certificate showing the studies completed to date (updated transcript of records or, if not available, provisional transcript) and associated grades;
- I details of a sponsoring teacher/ professor, who may be contacted by the admissions commission;
- I other optional certification (for example SAT/ACT or GMAT/GRE)

Exempted from the selection process for the Three-year and Single-cycle Degree Programs are candidates in possession of:

- I a SAT/ACT certificate with the following minimum scores: SAT - Total score 1090 (out of 1600) ACT - Total score 20 (out of 36)
- I IB Diploma obtained/to be obtained abroad with a minimum grade/predicted grade of 30. Students with a GPA of 5 out of 7 or higher in grade 11 may participate in the Luiss IB Honors Program to compete for the award of a fee waiver for the 2021/2022 a.y. in accordance with the terms of the related call.
- I Achievement of the Gaokao (National College Entrance Examination of China) with minimum scores to be determined based on the region, in accordance with the requisites determined by the relative call for applications which will be published starting from Spring 2021.

Exempted from the selection process for the Master's Degree Programs are candidates in possession of:

I A GMAT or GRE certificate with the following minimum scores: GMAT: 550 (out of 800) GRE: Verbal - 145 (out of 170) and Quantitative 145 (out of 170).


