

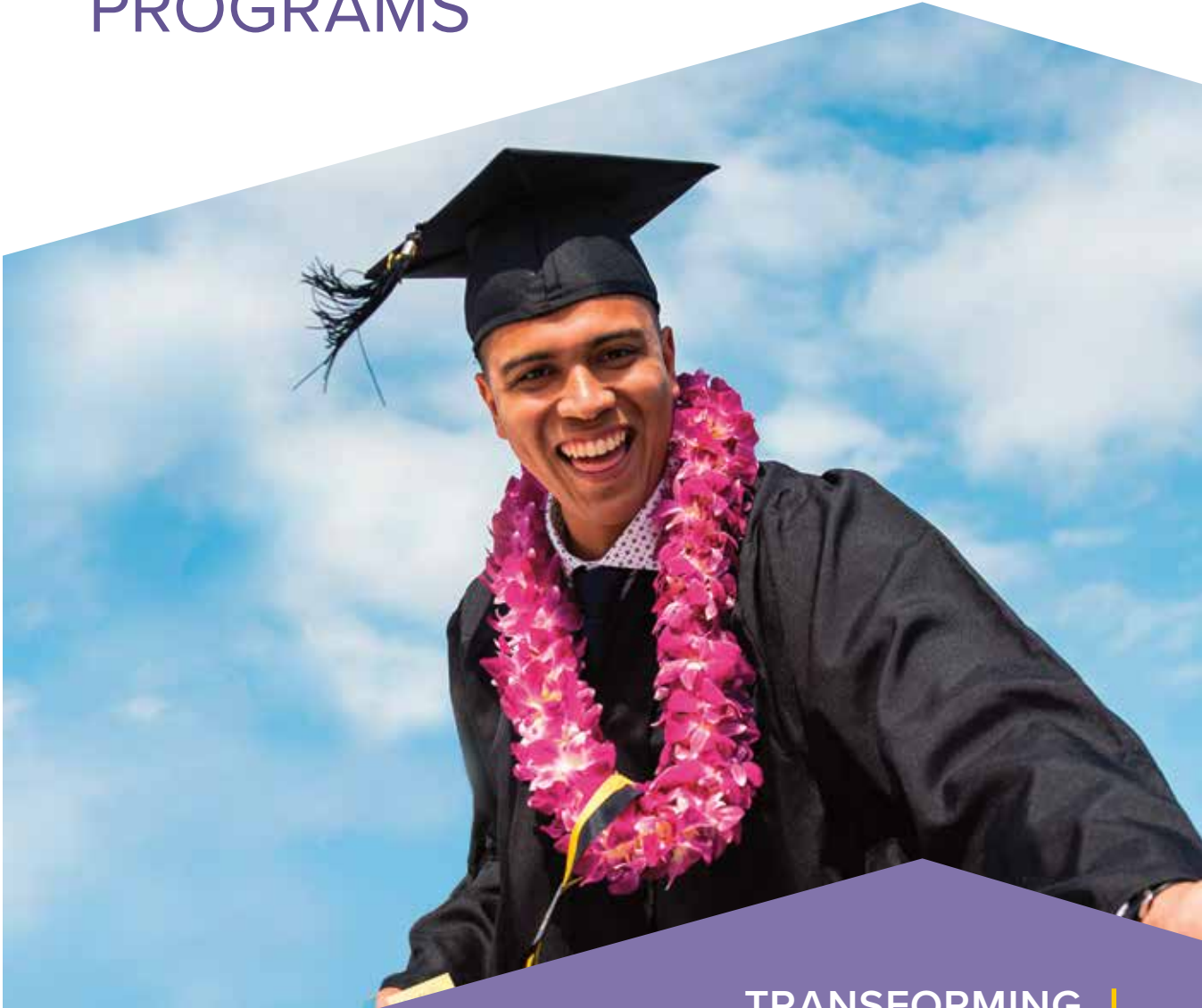

Minimum GPA: 3.0. **STEM Majors:** 3 years math, minimum GPA 3.0.
