Am I eligible?

English Language Requirement: Cambridge 169, TOEFL iBT 80, IELTS 6.0 each subsection, PTE 58, or completion of American Language Institute Level 6. Conditional Admission is offered through CSULB's American Language Institute for select graduate programs.

Minimum GPA: 2.5 (recommended 3.0) for the last 2 years of university coursework.

Some graduate programs may also require GRE or GMAT or have a higher GPA requirement.



How do I apply?

Apply online at CalState.edu/Apply. Fall application period: October 1–April 1. Spring application period: August 1–October 1. Many graduate programs have earlier application deadlines. Visit CSULB.edu/international for more information.
