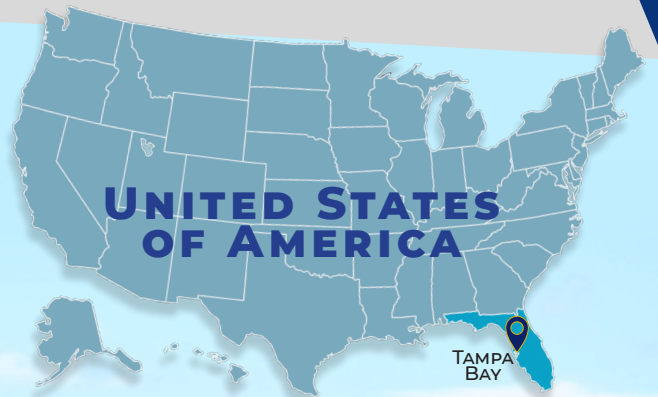

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

International student applicants from non-English speaking countries must provide proof of English proficiency to be admitted to the college. There are many ways to fulfill the English proficiency requirement, including a TOEFL score of at least 61 (iBT), an IELTS overall band score of 5.5 or higher, a minimum Duolingo English Test score of 95 or one of the following:

- 🇩🇰 DENMARK: Adgangsgivende eksamen (STX, HHX, HTX, HF) minimum grade of 7 in A-level English or 10 in B-level English
- 🇫🇮 FINLAND: Ylioppilastutkinto grade of 8 or higher; or M, E or L on a matriculation scale
- 🇩🇪 GERMANY: Gymnasium/Abitur of 7 or higher in LF classes; without LF, a grade of 10 or higher
- 🇮🇸 ICELAND: Students proof grade of 7 or higher
- 🇳🇱 NETHERLANDS: VWO grade of 7 or higher; HAVO grade of 7 or higher
- 🇳🇴 NORWAY: Vitnemal grade of 4 or higher
- 🇸🇪 SWEDEN: Avgångsbetyg grade of C or higher

HOUSING
