





Griffith College and ICHAS have collaborated for over 10 years in the delivery and hosting of ICHAS programmes.



*Academic Administration Fee is reviewed annually and is charged at the beginning of each academic year

An additional **QQI award fee** is also due in award year (ONLY).

Where a student commences a programme in the Spring intake, the Academic Administration Fee of €250* is applicable for the period January to August, with the Academic Administration Fee* payable again each September intake thereafter.

A €1,000 scholarship (Year 1 only) is available for bachelor degree programmes delivered on the Griffith College Dublin campus for students who pay a deposit before the 30th of June 2025. *No scholarships available for Pulse Faculty programmes.

Cork campus A 25% scholarship (Year 1 only) is available for bachelor degree programmes delivered on the Griffith College Cork campus for students who pay a deposit before the 30th of June 2025.

Postgraduate

A €500 scholarship is available for masters degree programmes delivered on any Griffith College campus for students who pay a deposit before the 30th of June 2025.


