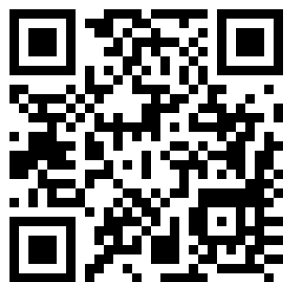

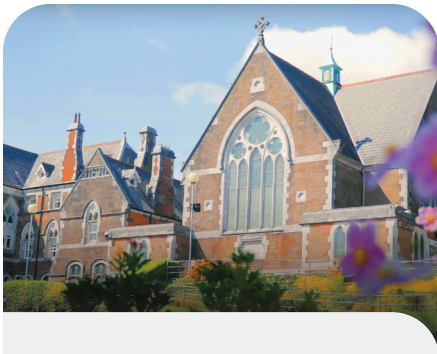


## DUBLIN
