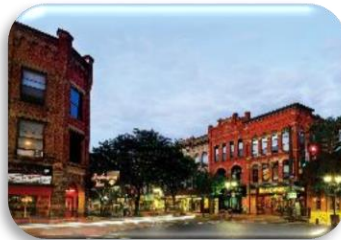

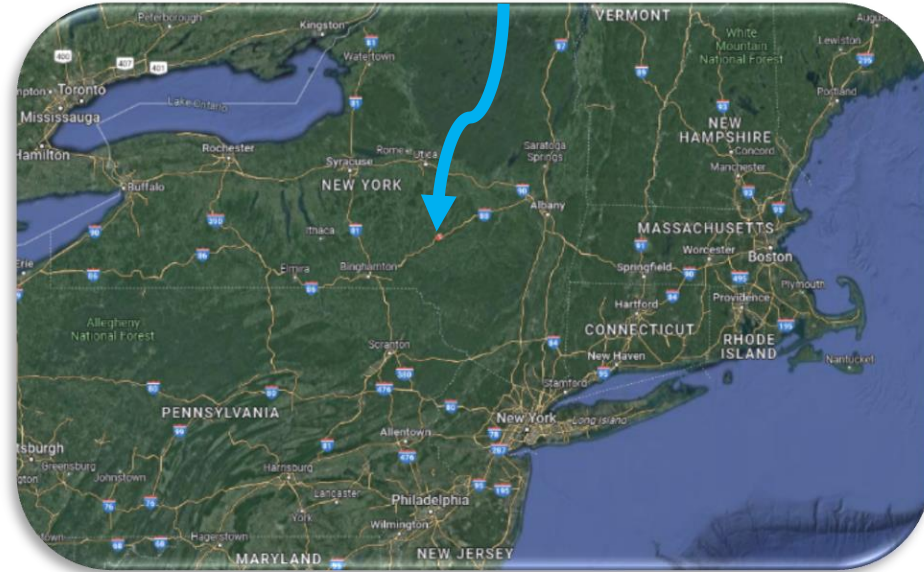

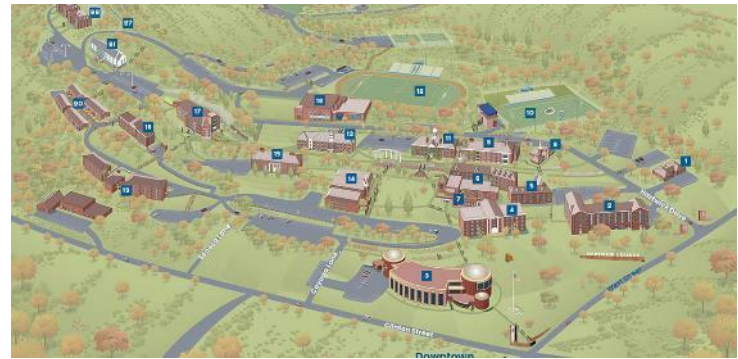

- Step 1: Complete and submit the following documents by email
- [Nomination form](#) to be completed by your international advisor
- [Visiting/exchange student application form](#)
- Recent photograph (passport photo preferred)
- TOEFL or IELTS Official Score Report or Home University Approved
- University transcripts

After admission

- Submit bank statement from a sponsor demonstrating that you have sufficient funds to pay for the program
- Pay \$400 deposit by deadline (May 15 (for fall admittance; November 2 for spring admittance)
- Complete [Medical Form](#) by deadline (July 15 for fall admittance; January 2 for spring admittance)
- Prepare for arrival at Hartwick College
