About Nebrija University

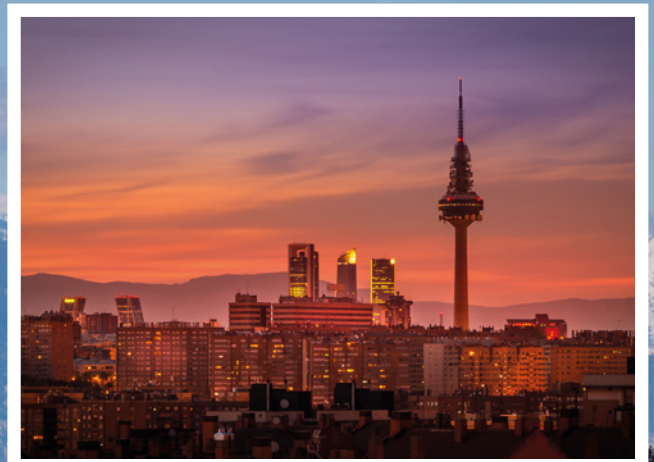

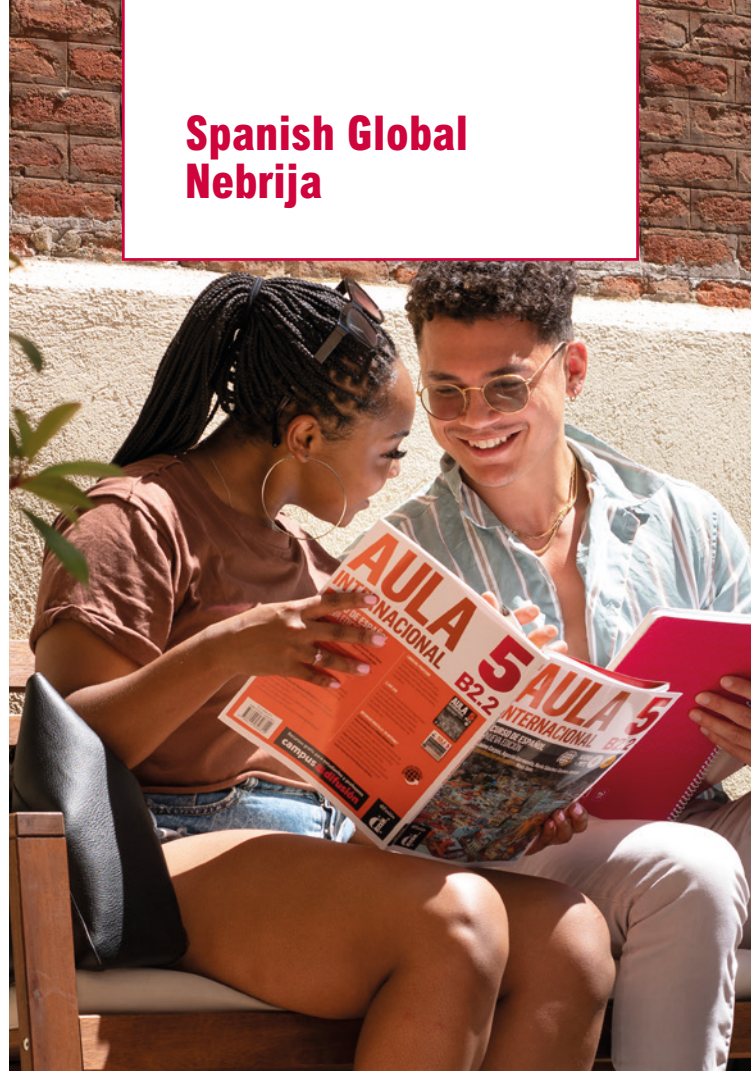

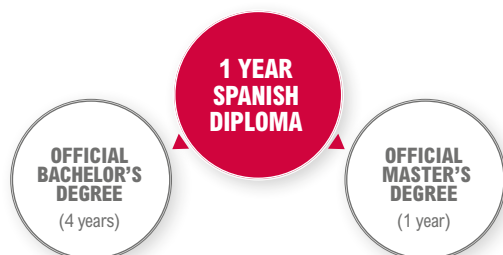


What do we offer?

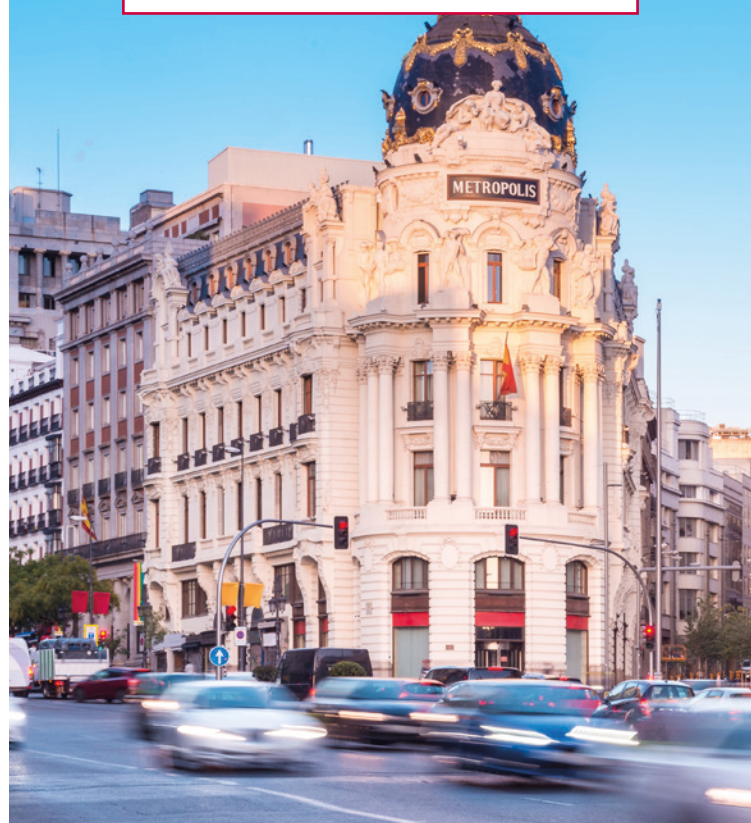
