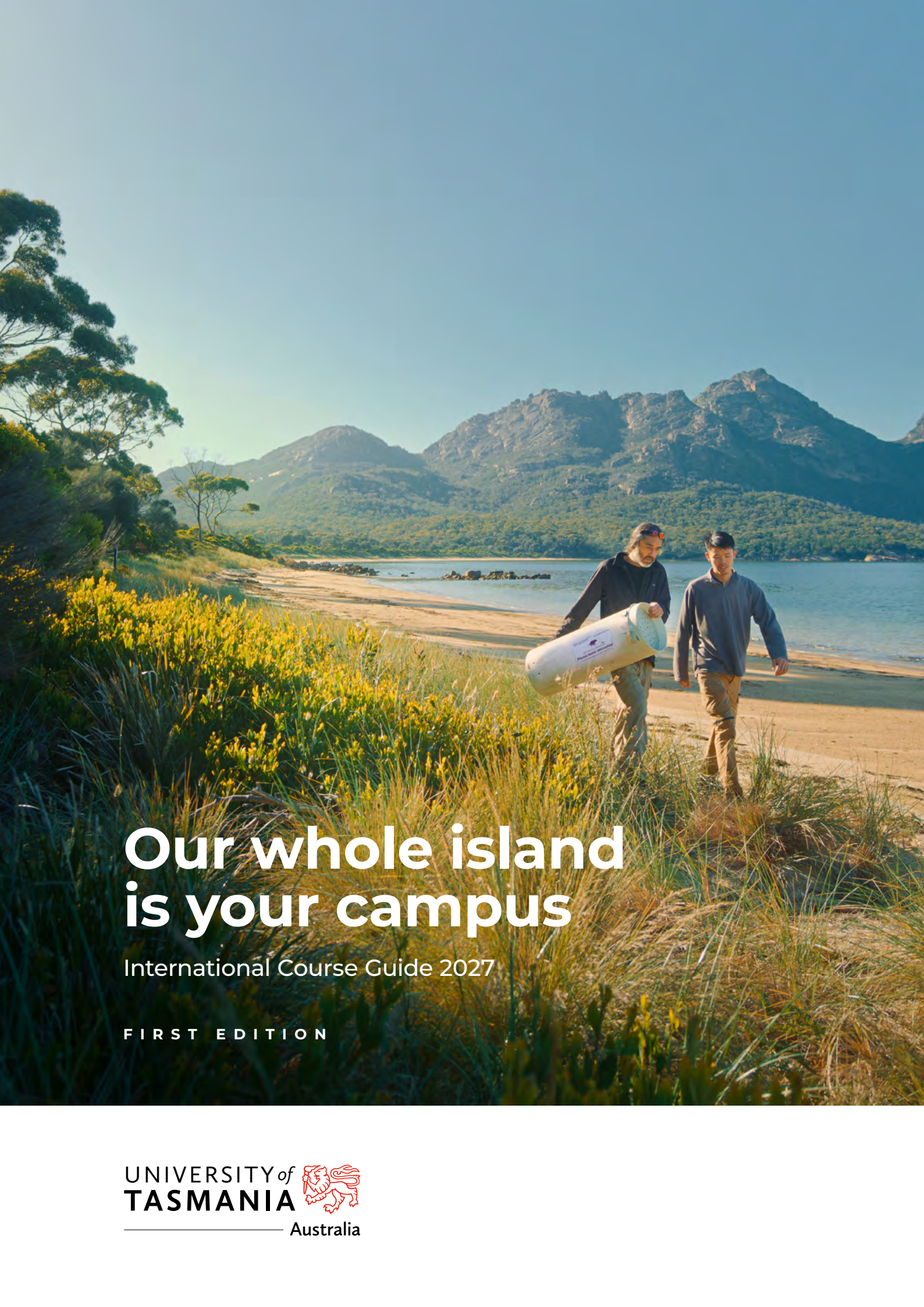

English language requirements

Minimum English language test score requirements

The table below sets out the minimum English language test scores you will need for entry into foundation, undergraduate and postgraduate coursework programs.

Keep in mind, these are just the starting point. Many undergraduate and postgraduate courses have higher English language requirements to ensure you are fully prepared to succeed from day one.

English language requirements

Some international applicants may need to provide evidence of an approved English language test completed within the last two years.

Key dates

If you're planning to study at the University of Tasmania as an international student, it's helpful to get across a few key dates early so everything runs smoothly.

Scholarships

At the University of Tasmania we offer a range of generous scholarships to help full fee-paying international students with their living and study expenses.



50% Tasmanian Aurora Excellence Scholarship

This scholarship welcomes applications from exceptional international students applying to undergraduate and postgraduate coursework degrees, offering a 50% reduction in registered tuition fees per year.



30% Tasmanian International Merit Scholarship

This scholarship recognises international students with outstanding academic achievement, applying for undergraduate and postgraduate coursework degrees and provides a 30% reduction in registered tuition fees per year.



25% International Alumni and Family scholarship

This scholarship provides international University of Tasmania alumni and family members of University of Tasmania students or alumni applying to undergraduate and postgraduate.



20% Tasmanian Access Scholarship

This scholarship is open to all international students applying to undergraduate and postgraduate degrees and covers 20% of registered tuition fees per year.
