Admissions Criteria

Admission to SolBridge is evaluated on a case-by-case basis taking into account the applicant's academic records, English proficiency, financial status, personal essay, extra-curricular activities, and letters of recommendation.

- Proof of High School Diploma
- Proof of Finances - bank statement or bank letter
- Copy of Passport - Photo Page
- One letter of recommendation
- Application fee of USD 50

- Copy of birth certificate or family certificate

Graduate Admissions Requirements

- Completed online application form
- Official Score of English Test (IELTS or equivalent)
- Academic Transcripts (original or validated copies) with a cumulative GPA of 2.0/4.0 or higher
- Proof of Finances - bank statement or bank letter

- Copy of Passport - Photo Page
- Original Bachelor's Degree Diploma (Masters) and Master's Degree (Ph.D.)
- Two letters of recommendation
- Application fee of USD 50
- Resume/CV
- Research Proposal (Ph.D.)
